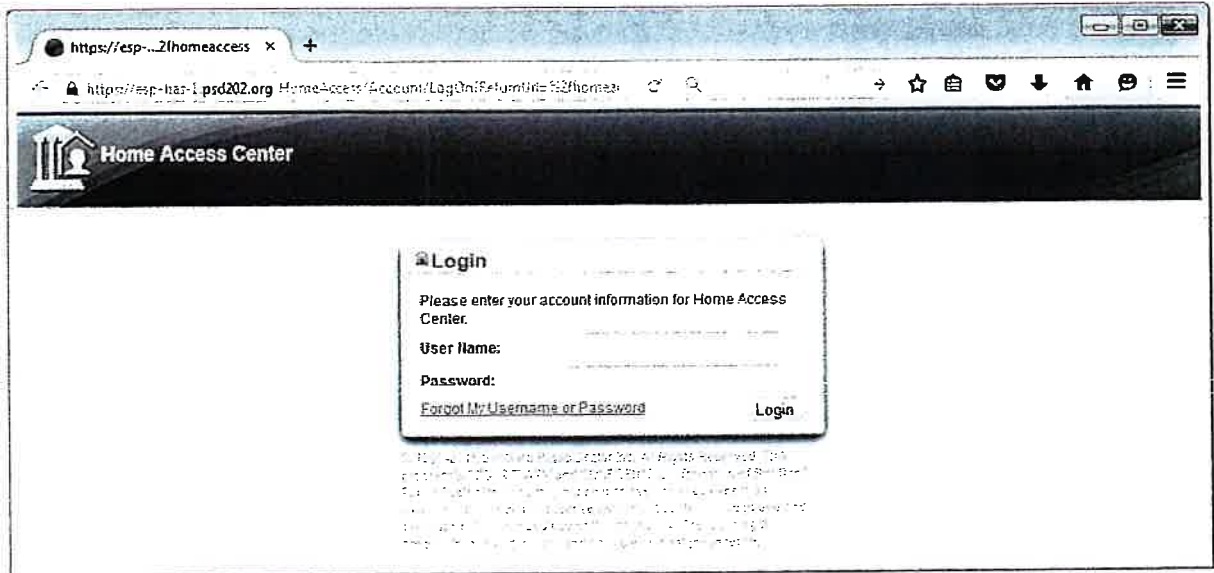

Home Access Center (HAC)

Home Access Center (HAC) Home Access Center is web-based software designed to allow you to securely view your student's information. You can access they system from our school website under Quick Links. You should see the screen the one below asking for your **Username** and **Password**.

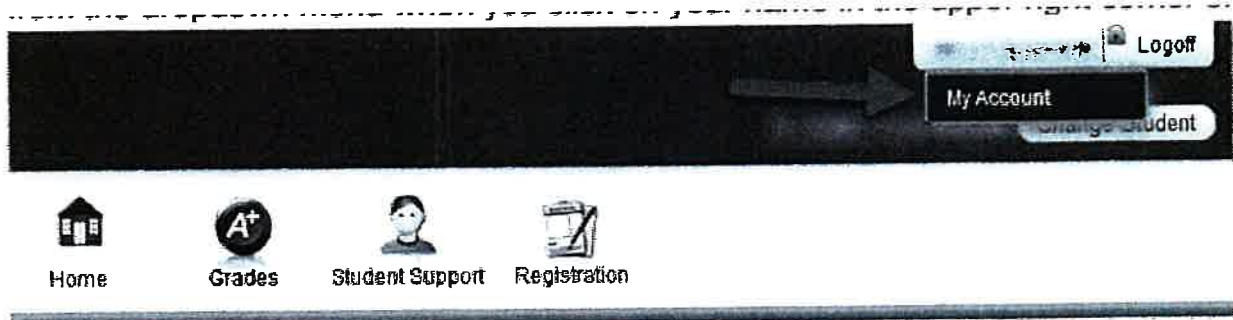


Your login information should have been provided to you in an email from your student's school. If you have not, or forgot your info, please call the school directly to have a reset done.

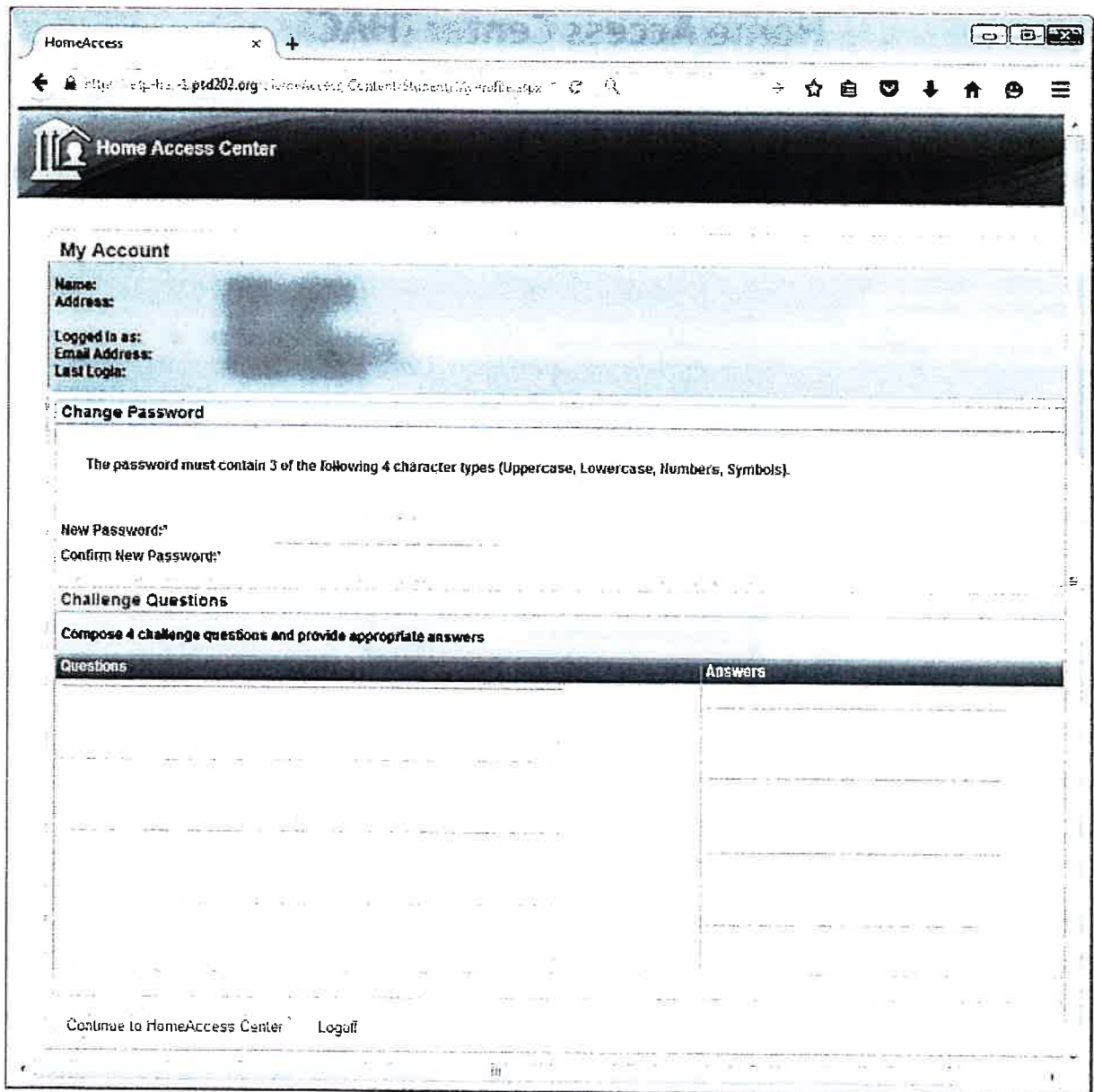
If you enter your Username or Password incorrectly seven times within a five-minute time span, your account will automatically lock for ten minutes.

Type your Username and Password in the corresponding fields and click the "Log In" button.

If you would like to change your password or challenge questions you can do that by clicking "My Account" from the dropdown menu when you click on your name in the upper right corner of the page.



After your first successful login to Home Access Center, you will be asked to change your password and set up four challenge questions and answers that you will use to recover your password if needed.



When setting your password, the system will require you to use a “strong” password format. “Strong” passwords include a combination of Upper and lowercase letters, Numbers or Symbols. Your password must be eight characters long and have three of the four types of acceptable characters listed above. (EX: March1990 is a valid password)

The system will also require that you provide a question and answer in each of the four question and answer boxes. Once you have completed the password change and challenge question entry, you may proceed to the next screen by clicking the “Continue to Home Access Center” button. This will take you to the basic information view for the students you are associated with in Plainfield School District 202.

If you are a NEW student enrolling for the following school year - Home Access center will not allow you to log in for the first time until the beginning of July as we are still in our “current year” of school.

If you have other students in the district – Home Access does allow you to toggle between all student’s accounts. There will be a drop down in the upper right-hand corner which allows you to choose which student you want to view.

2022/2023 Meal Program & School Fees

MySchoolBucks is our online school lunch payment portal; giving guardians a quick and easy way to manage and add funds to your student's meal account. Parents/guardians can view recent purchases, see current balances, plus add funds with no additional service charges. Enrollment is easy!

1. Go to www.myschoolbucks.com and register for a free account. A confirmation email will be sent to the address you provide; click on the link included in the email to activate your account.
2. Once your account is activated you may begin adding funds to your students lunch account. The student ID and school name will be required.
3. Funds may be added to your students' accounts with your Visa, MasterCard, Discover Card, debit card, or electronic check* with no additional service charge. Money deposited into mySchoolBucks.com appears in the student account within 24 hours.
4. An added benefit of MySchoolBucks is the "Set it and forget it" payment option, which allows you to schedule automatic payments to your student's meal account. Funds can be added weekly, monthly or when the balance hits a specified amount. This feature will allow you to automatically replenish your student's account on your terms.

Once you've signed up you can fund your student's account at www.myschoolbucks.com or on the mobile app, which is available for iPhone and Android devices. If you have any questions about myschoolbucks you can email parentsupport@myschoolbucks.com or call 1-855-832-5226

Online Student Fee Payment

This portion of this letter contains important information regarding 2022-2023 student fees. As stated in district policy, student fees must be paid in full by August 1st or be current on the district payment plan (see below for due dates) Fee's will be available to pay online after July 1.

Any student fee balance remaining after the August 1st due date will automatically be put on a payment plan.

Payment plan due dates: (payments may be made prior to the deadline)

August 1st of current school year – 34% of total fees owed

November 1st of current school year – 33% of total fees owed

February 1st of current school year – 33% of total fees owed

Our district uses an online fee payment system. This system lets District 202 families pay their school fees online and track their financial obligations throughout the year. The system will also reduce manual data entry for bookkeepers and secretaries, improve accurate record keeping and allow student fee data to be updated within 72 hours.
